

Article III: ASB Government

ASB Student Government shall not exceed a maximum of forty-two (42) Members.

Section II: General ASB Representatives

The General ASB Government Body shall consist of a maximum of six (6) Representatives per class. After internal ASB Government elections, positions include Class President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and two (2) senators.

Subsection II: Election Process of General ASB Representatives

Clause 1: The General ASB Government elections shall take place after the Executive Cabinet positions have been filled. The election committee shall determine the voting procedure.

Clause 2: Candidates for General ASB shall all initially run for the position of Class Representative. After a maximum of six (6) representatives are elected by their class to the General ASB Government, there will be an election for the positions of Class President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary by the newly elected ASB Government.

Sub-Clause 1: If a candidate for a class office loses their election, they shall then become a candidate for the next position on the chain of command. (E.g. President Candidate loses; he or she consequently becomes candidate for Vice President.)

Clause 3: Candidates must submit a Petition for Candidacy signed by 50 students from their class.

Clause 4: Any person wishing to run for ASB Government must not have three (3) or more referrals. This does not include parking and attendance and will be reviewed by the Vice Principle in charge of discipline.

Clause 5: Each candidate must submit an evaluation form from three (3) of their current teachers. These will be confidentially reviewed by the ASB Advisor or Vice Principle.

Clause 6: Candidates for an ASB Representative must have a cumulative GPA of 2.80 or higher.

Subsection III: Recall of General ASB Representatives

Section III: Leadership Delegates

Leadership Delegates shall consist of a maximum of twelve (12) students who were not elected through or did not participate in ASB Government elections.

Subsection I: Delegate Roles

Clause 1: Delegates shall perform the same duties as Class Senators.

Clause: Delegates shall not have voting rights in ASB Government matters.

Subsection II: Delegate Selection Process

Clause 1: Any student wishing to become a Leadership Delegate of ASB shall submit the application provided by the election committee.

Clause 2: Eligible candidates shall be interviewed and chosen by the Executive Board and ASB Advisor.

Section IV: Accountability of all ASB Government Officials

Clause 1: All ASB officials shall subject to a bi-monthly grade evaluation. If a member does not meet the grade requirements, they must complete a Plan of Action with their teacher and ASB advisor.

Clause 2: If a member's grades do not meet requirements during the Grade Evaluation directly subsequent to their completed Plan of Action, the member will be subject to suspension from ASB Government duties at the discretion of the Executive Cabinet and the ASB advisor.

Clause 3: If a suspended ASB Representative restores his or her grades within one month of suspension, they may appeal to the Executive Cabinet to be reinstated.

Clause 4: ASB Officials are expected to attend all General ASB meetings. If an Official misses 3 meetings in a row or 4 total meetings per semester without a legitimate excuse, they will be subject to dismissal from ASB Government at the discretion of the Executive Cabinet and ASB Advisor.

Clause 5: ASB Officials shall receive a warning of possible dismissal if they fail to attend 2 meetings.

Clause 6: ASB Officials shall be subject to performance evaluations by the Executive Board if they fail to meet the expectations of their position and the ASB Government as a whole.
