**Senior Walk:** The Senior Walk is scheduled for Friday 6/7 after school. This is when seniors go back to their elementary school dressed in cap and gown and walk through the halls while being celebrated by students and staff. It's fun and the elementary kids LOVE it! **Senior Finals:** Senior Finals are scheduled for Tuesday 6/11 and Wednesday 6/12.

- Do not wear your cap and gown to practice.
- Practice typically takes about 1.5 hours, but we will practice as long as we have to in order to get it right.

**Graduation Day:** Friday 6/14

- There is NO SCHOOL for you today!
- Please meet us in the gym at 5:45 PM with your cap and gown. After checking in we will take a senior class picture, etc.
- The ceremony will begin at 7:00 PM.

**Diplomas:** Diplomas will be available for pick up in the commons on Thursday, 6/27.

- Diplomas may only be picked up by the student or their parent/guardian.

**Other things you should know:**

- We don't use tickets for our graduation ceremony, everyone is welcome and seating is first come first served. There is disabled seating available, please let Ms. Mak or Ms. Van Weezendonk know if someone in your group needs special seating.
- The graduation ceremony takes about an hour.
- Yes, you may decorate the top of your graduation cap – please keep it school appropriate.
- Just something to be aware of - graduation gowns only go down to mid shin.
- Beware of walking in tall heels – the plastic is very slippery and covered in holes.
- Everything will be BLINDINGLY white (even on a cloudy day) – consider bringing sunglasses.
- Students going to Grad Night after the ceremony – you will be receiving a letter from the PTA with instructions regarding meet up times, location, etc.
- Information regarding Senior Sunset will come from the ASB.
