Prom: Prom is Saturday, June 1st – PLEASE make good choices. Don't risk graduation!

Senior Awards Night:

- Thursday 6/6 at 6:30 in the Auditorium
- Please check in when you arrive (there will be a table at the top of the main entrance stairs in the mezzanine area)
- If you didn't get an invite and think that you should have, please check with Mrs. Simkins in the library

Other Important Dates:

- **Friday 6/7**
 - unreturned textbooks become fines. It is ok to keep textbooks to prepare for finals but please turn them in immediately after your final. Library fines can keep you from walking. If you are not sure if you have fines or outstanding books, please stop by the library and ask.
 - Senior Walk after school. This is when seniors go back to their elementary school dressed in cap and gown and walk through the halls while being celebrated by students and staff. It's fun and the elementary kids LOVE it! If you didn't go to elementary school in Poulsbo, tag along with your friends to their elementary school. Not school sponsored – drive yourself.

- **Thursday 6/13**
 - Senior Slide Show @ 9:00 AM in the auditorium. Attendance is optional (but it's fun and in past years students have said that they were glad they went!)
 - Graduation Practice @ 10:00 AM (right after the Senior Slideshow) and begins at 10 AM sharp in the Stadium. Attendance is MANDATORY (you will not walk if you do not practice).
 - Do not wear your cap and gown to practice.
 - Practice typically takes about 1.5 hours, but we will practice as long as we have to in order to get it right.
 - Senior Picnic at Raab Park – the picnic starts when Mrs. Sawicki signs off on graduation practice.

- **Friday 6/14**
 - Graduation Day! There is NO SCHOOL for you today! Please meet us in the gym at 5:45 PM with your cap and gown. After checking in we will take a senior class picture, etc. The ceremony will begin at 7:00 PM.
- **Thursday 6/27**
 - Diplomas will be available for pick up in the commons today and may only be picked up by the student or their parent/guardian. If you can't pick up your diploma on this date please check the Graduation section of our website or stop by the office for other options.

High School and Beyond: You WILL NOT graduate if you do not complete this. Uploading your resume to WOIS is a state requirement. If you haven't completed this, contact your counselor ASAP.

Cap & Gown: You must have a cap and gown if you are planning to walk. You can still graduate without it, but you won't be walking in the graduation ceremony. If you need help with this talk to Mak or Ms. Van Weezendonk ASAP.

Tickets, Seating and Disabled Seating at Graduation:

- There are no tickets to graduation – seating is first come, first served
- Seats cannot be reserved earlier in the day
- Graduation is in the stadium no matter what the weather (with the exception of thunder and lightning)
- If you have a family member who requires handicap seating contact Mak or Ms. Van Weezendonk ASAP to reserve a spot. Handicap seats are not labeled there will be a reserved section with enough room for everyone who requested one.

Graduation Attire:

- It is ok to decorate your cap but it must be school appropriate
- All of the white sheeting is slippery – reconsider if you are planning to wear heels
- All of the sheeting is blindingly white (even on a gray day) – bring sunglasses

PTSA Grad Night Party: If you bought a ticket you should have received info about the event directly from the PTSA. In a nutshell:

- Wear comfy clothes, close toed shoes, and bring a hoodie or light jacket
- Bring your ID but don't bring bags, purses or wallets
- Meet at the Tech Ed building between 8:45-9:00 to board the busses
- Once you are on the bus you cannot get off
- There are bathrooms on the bus
- The bus leaves at 9:30 and they WILL leave you behind if you aren't there on time
- The busses will return you to the Walmart parking lot between 6:15 – 6:30 AM. Do not leave your car parked at the school overnight.
