To be considered for Guest Status:

- Student must be in 9th grade (no middle school students), and may not exceed 20 years of age.
- Agree to follow the guidelines and rules of NKHS and NK School District, any guest not following the rules will be removed.
- Sponsoring student must turn in this form into the main office for administrator approval **by 2:00pm on the last Wednesday before the dance.**

Dance Guest must:

- Show school ID, or picture ID with verification of age (driver's license, military ID).
- Enter and leave with the NKHS student who purchased their ticket.

Important to know:

- Students and guests who leave the dance without a chaperone will not be allowed reentry.
- You cannot buy your guest's ticket until you have the completed guest pass.
- Tickets will not be issued; entry based on list of students who purchased tickets.

To: Guests at NKHS Dance

NKHS Dances are a school-sponsored event. As outlined on bulletin boards, announcements, on this contract and via broadcasts, all students including guests must be dressed appropriately.

If Dance Rules, Dress Code and Guest Procedures are not followed:

- 1) You will NOT be permitted to attend the dance.
- 2) You and/or your guest will NOT receive a refund for your tickets for this event.

	DANCE RULES	DRESS CODE
Guest Initial	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All NKHS students and guests WILL be asked for photo ID for confirmation of age and identity. 2. NO guest may be 21 years of age or older. 3. Guests MUST be at least a freshman. 4. NO person on suspension or expulsion from any school including NKHS may attend a NKHS dance. 5. NO person known for or suspected of a crime or violent act in a public school may attend. 6. All Guests MUST adhere to all school and dance rules. 7. All bags are subject to search. 8. Sexually suggestive dance movements are NOT allowed. This includes but is not limited to: lap dancing, grinding, groping, on the floor dancing. Students will be subjected to removal from the dance and NO refunds given. Face to Face and leave some space. 9. NO person will be allowed to re-enter the dance. 10. NO person will be admitted to a dance after 9:30 PM 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Undergarments must be covered by outerwear. 2. Strapless dresses and those with spaghetti straps are allowed. 3. See-through material is NOT allowed in groin, buttock and breasts areas; however, cleavage alone will not constitute a dress code violation. 4. Dresses MUST cover groin and buttocks area. 5. Not allowed: clothing that advocates drug or alcohol use, illegal activity or violence, sexual messages, vulgarity, profanity or is determined by law enforcement to be affiliated with gangs. 6. Dances are considered semi-formal events. While tuxes are not required, sweats, jeans, casual caps, and t-shirts are not permitted. 7. Sunglasses, face paint or masks may NOT be worn. 8. If you do not comply with this dress code, you will NOT be permitted to enter and you will NOT receive a refund. 9. Shoes must be worn. If heels are removed, flip flops are an appropriate alternative.
Guest Initial	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11. NO tickets will be sold at the door. 12. The sale or transfer of tickets will not be permitted. All students entering the dance will be on a pre-approved list, NO Exceptions. 13. Possession of a guest pass will not prevent any school administrator, chaperone, or security officer from refusing admission to any non-student. 14. Please do not bring overnight bags to be stored at school. 15. No use of lockers will be permitted. 	

If you have any questions, please contact Mr. Prince, Activities Director. NO exceptions will be made to these guidelines for students attending NKHS or their guest.

It is your responsibility to ensure your guest is aware of NKHS policies. A Guest Pass **MUST** be completed and turned in for administrative approval no later than the **Wednesday** before the dance.

With the purchase of your ticket(s), you acknowledge these responsibilities and your signature signifies you understand and will abide by the Dress Code and Dance Rules of NKHS.
