## STUDENT INFORMATION

- **Course Registration:** The course registration process for the 2020-2021 school year begins this week. Current 9th-11th grade students will receive a copy of their transcript, graduation requirement sheet, and course selection sheet during their English classes on Monday, 2/24. There will be a video presentation during study sessions – 9<sup>th</sup> on Tues. 2/25 during 2<sup>nd</sup> study session, 10<sup>th</sup> on Wed. 2/26, and 11<sup>th</sup> on Tues. 2/25 2<sup>nd</sup> study session. You'll register online from home this year beginning Friday 2/28. Please see our website for all of the details.
- **ASVAB Test:** The ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) will be given on Tuesday, March 3 from 12:15pm- 2:25pm in the library and is FREE! The test helps students identify their skills and interests, explore jobs, and develop after high school plans. Students can sign up in the Career Center, Library or Counseling Office.
